We are so excited you are here! We love welcoming new players into our bingo family and hope you have a wonderful time playing with us. Here are THREE tips to help you get started...

1. Be sure to yell 'BINGO' on the last number called. So this is how it works... when you see your winning number on the TV and you just daubed that number to complete your winning pattern, wait for the caller to call the number on the monitor and then yell 'BINGO' as loud as you can so the caller can hear you!

2. Speedball is fast paced and requires the attention of everyone in the hall. So as not to interrupt the game, we request everyone to be very quiet until the speedball game is complete.

3. Want to INCREASE your chances at winning? Try this...

★ **Play BINGO ELECTRONICS**... they are the EASIEST way to play & allow you to play up to 66 cards at once! You get 10 Red & 10 Blue Speeds as well. Bonanza is NOT included, they are sold 2/\$1.

★ **Play PULL TABS**... while your electronics are doing their job minding your bingo cards, you can play pull tabs at the same time to double your chances at a big win.

## How to set up your... BINGO COMPUTER

Once you purchase your bingo products from the cashier, pick up your Lucky Computer attain at the back wall!

To activate the Computer, tap the screen and then enter the Account Number on your receipt.

That's it...you're ready to play! Each computer plays and tracks your 66 bingo cards and will alert you when to yell 'BINGO'.


## How to Mark & Play...

## BONANZA

Each 12 Pack of Cards comes with a Purple Tint Bonanza Game. This is the LAST Game of the Night. Worth \$750!



There are two types of Bonanza Boards in the Hall. We pull 45 balls at 6pm. You'll need to mark those numbers on the Purple Sheets. The boards look like this...



Once you mark those sheets, set them aside. You will not need them again until the last game of the night.

For the Bonanza Game we will begin calling the 46th number. You will need a COVERALL to bingo on one.

This game is worth \$750. You can purchase more of these sheets with a Floor Worker, they are 2/\$1.

## Dab Instant Win Tickets

Redeem these tickets immediately. Simply open the ticket and if the symbols inside the ticket match the winning combination on the front of the ticket, you win the amount displayed inside the ticket.

## Dab Hold Tickets

**HOLD TICKETS** have more than one bingo number between B1 and O75, sometimes a "FREE" ball, and are held for a chance at the larger prize(s). The "FREE" ball is dabbed immediately.



## HOLD TICKETS

Once all tickets in the game are sold, the caller begins the bingo pull tab game by calling each ball that is pulled from the bingo machine. The first player to cover all or dab all the numbers on their pull tab ticket, yells 'BINGO' and wins the prize and the large designated tab game amount on the front of the ticket. A floor worker will verify your winning ticket and pay out the prize!

**Each bingo pulltab ticket game has a pre-determined ticket count with both INSTANT winner tickets and a series of HOLD tickets.**

**2** Race ticket games may also contain a “single hold” ticket numbered anywhere between B1 & O75. The player holding the ticket number of the last number called for a verified bingo wins the second level prize. In some cases, all players holding the ticket numbers in the entire downrow on the flashboard may win the second level prize. A floor worker will verify your winning ticket and pay out the prize!

**Hold Tickets B1 through B15 corresponds to the downrow on the Flashboard. The 1st player to complete the five numbers in the downrow based on the numbers called by the caller, WINS!**

"Single Hold" Tickets are numbered between B1 & O75. The player holding the ticket of the last number called for a verified bingo wins!
